Annual report on CSR activities for the financial year ended 31st March, 2022

1. A brief outline of the Company's CSR policy:

Your Company continues to support the activities of Medha Charitable Trust ('MCT'). MCT was already undertaking various educational schemes such as Medha Helping Hands ('MHH'), Medha Sampurna Siksha ('MSS'), Medha Naipunya Nirmana ('MNN') and Medha Vidyalaya Navikarana ('MVN'). During the year under review, MCT turned a new leaf by setting up Medha Center of Excellence Scheme ('MCOE'), an advanced welding training facility in association with Institute of Welding and Testing Technology (IWTT), Mumbai. MCOE is equipped with state of the art machinery such as MIG/MAG/TIG welding systems and welding simulators from Fronius India Pvt. Ltd. Each year around 75 candidates will be provided 4 months training on Advanced Welding and placements assistance will be provided at the end of the coursework.

Your CSR Committee has evaluated such schemes of the Trust and the usefulness to the end beneficiaries who belong to the economically weaker section of the Society. The CSR committee has recommended for financial aid for executing the schemes of MCT which will also enable the Company to fulfill it's CSR obligations. Based on the recommendations of the CSR Committee, your Board has approved and disbursed an amount of Rs. 1,33,50,000 (Rupees One Crore Thirty Three Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) for the financial year 2021-22.
