### Annual report on CSR activities for the financial year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024

#### 1. A brief outline of the Company's CSR policy:

Your Company continues to support the activities of Medha Charitable Trust ('MCT'). MCT has been undertaking various educational schemes such as Medha Helping Hands ('MHH'), Medha Sampurna Siksha ('MSS'), Medha Naipunya Nirmana ('MNN') and Medha Vidyalaya Navikarana ('MVN') and Medha Center of Excellence Scheme ('MCOE'), an advanced welding training facility in association with Institute of Welding and Testing Technology (IWTT), Mumbai, your Board has expressed their satisfaction over such educational programmes of the Trust and adopted the same towards fulfilment of CSR obligations of your company.

Based on the recommendations of the CSR Committee, your Board has approved and disbursed an amount of Rs.1,01,02,879/- (Rupees One Crore One Lakh Two Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy Nine Only) in several tranches to Medha Charitable Trust for carrying out its educational programmes for the financial year 2023-24.

During the year under review, your Board has also received a request from Aarohi Blood Bank (which sources, screens and provided blood with specific target beneficiaries being children with Thalassemia) for support of an amount of Rs.5,00,000/-. Same has been recommended by the CSR committee and Board has approved the same. Said amount was donated to Aarohi Blood bank thereby contributing for the public health care under CSR activities of the Company.
